Davis Coen : Magnolia Land

Davis Coen's string of high quality blues recordings continues with the masterwork, *Magnolia Land*.

Coen continues to strive to bring out the big band sound on "Tired and Lonesome," a wailing stomper that starts the disc. Coen's fuzz toned guitar workouts accompany his husky vocal delivery on the humming gem, "Change in the Weather." Stripped blues and bottleneck leads dominate "Country Girl Blues" as Coen digs deep to sing mournfully, heightening the tension and release within the composition. "Nothing to Hold On To" is a slow, strutting ballad with a radio-friendly chorus.

Two separate rhythm units occupy *Magnolia Land*, with Jimbo Mathus on bass and Darin Dortin on drums for one half, and Justin Showah on bass with Kinney Kimbrough on drums for the other. Recorded by Mathus at Delta Recording Service in Como, Mississippi, *Magnolia Land* is a first class ticket to visceral blues heaven with Davis Coen confidently leading the way.

Magnolia Land is out now on Soundview.

Davis Coen's sixth release finds him continuing where he left off with last year's *Blues Lights for Yours and Mine*. His rough-hewn charm grows more appealing with its familiarity as he strays further from Piedmont acoustic guitar and deeper into Mississippi Hill Country with a full, electric-band sound. On *Magnolia Land*'s 12 tracks, slide guitars are cranked up and played in disjointed teamwork, drums and bass work overtime, and Coen sings in a lazy, slurring, Dylan-esque

style that keeps you in suspense over whether he'll even hit the right notes. You'll find yourself absorbed by the muddled but highly rhythmic style.

The live-in-the-studio sound benefits from Coen's laid-back, bare-bones approach and from his backup musicians, who hail from North Mississippi and Memphis. Lance Ashley plays B-3; producer Jimbo Mathus doubles on bass and electric guitar; Afrissippi members Justin Showah and Kinney Kimbrough play drums and bass, respectively.

"Goin' Away Baby," the disc's best track, is propelled by a powerful rhythm section, convincing vocals, and snarling guitar. Other highlights include "Shake Your Goo-bie," a backroom breakdown of Burnside proportions; "Country Girl Blues," an arsenal of stinging slide; and "You Gonna Miss Me," a locomotive take on Muddy Waters' original. Howlin' Wolf's "Natchez Burning" is wildly out-of-tune in places yet bewitching. And who would guess the traditional "Shortnin' Bread" could find a new pulse thanks to Coen's understated approach? There are six originals as well, and Coen sings them with such confidence you'd swear you already know them. Coen is carrying the torch for an essential subset of the blues, illuminating it with a fresh, satisfying style.



Soundview artist: Davis Coen - *These Things Shall Pass* - New Release Review



I just had the opportunity to review the most recent release, **These Things Shall Pass**, from **Davis Coen** and it's quite good. Mississippi based Coen, decided to put together a spiritual based release and this one is exceptional. Opening with Willie Banks and the Messengers' **Working For Jesus**, Coen shows an exceptional feel for R&B style backed by Patrick McClary and Ryan Rogers on drums. With a country flavor, **Stand By You** is a cool track with smart vocals and lush steel guitar riffs. Pop rocker, **Diamonds In Your Back Yard**, has a simple melody, a catchy hook and warm vocal blending. A cool radio track. **Saint Christopher** has a real nice New Orleans kind of feel with great piano lines and vocal pairing. On the traditional, **What A Friend We Have In Jesus**, Coen plays it pretty much by the book but with a nice rhythm acoustic guitar and sweet slide echoes. Very nice. One of my favorites on the release, **Shifting The Tide**, has a strong soul feel and Coen's vocals are dynamic. Acoustic piano gives the track a real earthiness and warm backing vocals cement the deal. Excellent! **Jesus' Hand** has a great revival feel, backed by McClary on vocal and a snappy drum line by Rogers. Another R&B style track, **Lord, Let Me Do Right** is particularly nice with arpeggiated chords and sweet vocals. The most direct gospel track, **You Are The Onliest (God I Know)** moderate guitar work but mostly acoustic piano cementing this track firmly on the ground. Very nice. Country blues (and title) track, **These Things Will Pass**, previously covered by Hank Snow and Johnny Cash is extremely effective. Super solid track. Wrapping the release is the traditional, **Old Rugged Cross**. Coen sells this track like it's his own with acoustic guitar and mandolin adornment and accompaniment. A really strong closer to a particularly strong release.

On a song about being unemployed, *I'm Gonna Move to Another Country*, Welch romps as Ledbetter soars. After releasing this disc, which Welch calls "probably the best music I ever made," they may prefer maintaining their home base in America for now.

QUINN SULLIVAN

Midnight Highway

Provogue – PRD 7516 2

A protégé of Buddy Guy, Quinn Sullivan has spent almost his entire career playing the blues and developing his own style. He started at the age of three playing with the kids' music combo Toe Jam Puppet Band; by the time he was eight, Guy had already taken the young guitarist under his wing. Now 17, Sullivan is on his third album, and *Midnight Highway* showcases his instinct for plugging into a wide variety of musical styles, from pop-inflected guitar ballads (*Tell Me I'm Not Dreaming*) to straight-ahead blues (*Something for Me*).

Tom Hambridge's crisp production allows Sullivan's voice—which is more pop than blues, at least on this album—to become an instrument as powerful as his guitar licks. Hambridge, who also plays drums on the album and writes or co-writes all but one track, gathers a stellar group of musicians to back Sullivan, including bassists Michael Rhodes and Tom MacDonald, guitarist Rob McNelley and keyboard player Reese Wynans. *Lifting Off*, a Hambridge-Sullivan co-write, rockets off with Sullivan's crunchy, chicken-picked blues riffs just ahead of Wynans' soaring synthesizer, propelling an urgent I-can't-live-without-you message. On the title track, Sullivan stretches out vocally and musically on a tune reminiscent of an early Allman Brothers' tune; it's a declaration that the road wears the singer out, but nevertheless he embraces it because of the beauty and mystery life on the road often reveals: "I gotta keep ridin' down that midnight highway / on the open road there's so much to see." Covering George Harrison's *While My Guitar Gently Weeps* challenges any musician, but Sullivan succeeds because he's wise enough to hew closely to the power of the original while inflecting it with his own searing lead riffs. On *Rocks*, Elvin Bishop meets Deep Purple in Sullivan's jaunty blues rocker.

While many young blues guitarists try to flaunt flash and speed, Sullivan displays on *Midnight Highway* a musical maturity,

illustrating with every tune that he knows he's mastered tone and phrasing and inflection. His openness to explore a wide range of musical styles, and his ability to play them, indicates that Sullivan's musical future shines, and that we can expect much more from him.

These Things Shall Pass


Given that blues, country and gospel all basically share a street in the same musical neighborhood, it's not a stretch for a blues artist to record the occasional gospel side, but on *These Things Shall Pass*, Mississippi singer-songwriter Davis Coen goes a step further by releasing an entire album of spiritually based songs.

Coen's music is equal parts blues, country and Americana, and he's managed to carve a nice niche for himself thanks in part to some high profile platforms that have featured his music. Coen contributed backing music to Martin Scorsese's 2003 PBS special *The Blues* and to the reality TV show *Lizard Lick Towing*. He's also a regular on the blues festival scene, having shared a stage with luminaries like Koko Taylor, R.L. Burnside and Bonnie Raitt.

The album—Coen's tenth full-length release—is produced by Coen and Ryan Rogers and, among the 12 tracks, includes nine songs written or co-written by Coen. Rather than trying to simply blues-up songs from the hymnal, Coen delivers a gospel album that stays true to the genre while offering ample nods to his blues and country roots. He fuels every song with his loose and languid guitar, warm voice and eclectic influences and he presents a nice blend of styles, ranging from upbeat revival tent shakers to mournful ballads and confessional hymns.

The album kicks off with a soulful, mid-tempo spin on Willie Banks and the Messengers' *Working for Jesus*, with Damein Wash and former Billy Joe Shaver guitarist Patrick McClary testifying with sweet backing vocals before downshifting to the spare, pedal steel driven, traditional-sounding original *Stand By You*.

Saint Christopher, a playful shuffle duet with McClary, is one of the CD's strongest cuts and features inspired, Sunday worship service piano by Eric Carlton, who shines throughout the album. The foot stomper *Jesus' Hand*, another vocal collaboration with



McClary, could get the congregation dancing in the pews.

Perhaps in an effort to give them more gravitas, Coen sings traditional standards *What a Friend We Have in Jesus* and *Old Rugged Cross* with a deadpan delivery that leaves them wanting for a bit more emotion. In contrast, the original *You Are the Onliest (God I Know)* is a superb testimonial with just piano and reverb guitar in which the occasional falsetto, used so effectively on previous Coen releases, makes a welcome appearance. The title track is pretty much straight up country and is laced with splendid pedal steel and Coen's acoustic strumming.

Coen has done a nice job of crafting a gospel album on which both purists and casual listeners can find something to like.

Newly released on DVD, *On the Blue Highway* is a highly personal, 73-minute documentary portrait of decades in the life of the Nighthawks, a blues band started by harpist/vocalist Mark Wenner who remains at the helm. The Washington, DC, blues scene of the 1970s-'80s, said to have been a musical melting pot, comes to life. Included are interviews with current and former members, some of whom have been with the band for more than 30 years. The past is well documented in old stills and even a few rough video clips from the time.

Davis Coen – *These Things Shall Pass*

In the last seventeen years, singer and songwriter Davis Coen has had a prolific career, at least based on the fact that he now has ten recordings on his resume. Typically his music is a mix of blues and country. However, he has long harbored a desire to record an album that features his spiritual influences. Enlisting a number of friends to help out, Coen delivers a primer on spiritual salvation with eight original hymns, two co-written, and four covers.

Drummer Ryan Rogers establishes a solid foundation on the opener, “Working For Jesus,” written by the legendary Willie Mitchell and originally done by Willie Banks and the Messengers. Coen expounds on the difficulties of maintaining the faith as Eric Carlton on organ creates the appropriate atmosphere.

The title track, written by Stuart Hamblen, adds the singer’s country influences, thanks to the pedal steel guitar of Kell Kellum. “Lesser Man” is built around Carlton on piano and an earnest vocal from Coen. Guitarist Patrick McClary joins the leader for several duets, “Saint Christopher” being a gently rollicking blues-country-gospel highlight while “Jesus’ Hand,” which the two singers wrote, dials up the gospel fever over the Nathan Robbins thumping bass work.


Standout tracks include “Diamonds In Your Back Yard,” a song reminding listeners that joy is all around us, waiting to be discovered. Coen is equally compelling on “Shifting The Tide,” sharing his passion with a vocal chorus to create a Sunday experience. The stripped-down arrangement for “You Are the Onliest (God I Know)” leaves plenty of space for the singer’s personal testament on faith. Kellum’s returns on “Stand By You,” setting up an stimulating musical interplay between his pedal steel and Carlton on piano. Coen’s measured approach fails to inspire on two stalwart hymns, “What A Friend We Have In Jesus” and “Old Rugger Cross,” the later getting a boost from Jonny Ciaramitaro on mandolin. Several other artists, singer Damein Wash and bass player Stuart Cole, also make contributions to the project.

Davis Coen can cross this one off his bucket list. While this project is centered on faith and religion, the singer refrains from trying to recreate the passionate performances of the best gospel groups. He utilizes a laid-back style that suits his abilities, and allows him to deliver his message utilizing a range of styles. It is a solid effort from this well-traveled musician, aimed at those who feel a need for redemption.
